Coming off the recent reunion tour of "**On A Winter's Night**" featuring veteran singer-songwriters who remain among the brightest stars of the singer/songwriter movement for the past three decades -- Patty Larkin, John Gorka, Lucy Kaplansky and Cliff Eberhardt, **Patty Larkin is back!** After suffering a spinal cord injury that left Patty paralyzed from the neck down a year and a half ago, Patty is excited to return to the stage after surgery and months of rigorous rehabilitation and therapy.

Over the years, Patty Larkin has redefined the boundaries of folk-urban pop music with her inventive guitar wizardry and uncompromising lyrics and vocals. Described as "riveting" (Chicago Tribune) and "hypnotic" (Entertainment Weekly), Patty Larkin has captured audiences for over 30 years with her imagination and technical artistry. In her 14th release **Bird in a Cage**, she mines the intersection of poetry and song, featuring ten notable poets, including **five US Poet Laureates**, for an innovative and haunting musical collection. Poems are made to be shared aloud, and with *Bird*, Patty takes up that tradition and sets it aglow.

Recent projects include **Still Green**, written in a national seashore dune shack and **25**, a retrospective of duets with 25 friends, including **Shawn Colvin, Bruce Cockburn, Suzanne Vega, John Gorka**, among others. Her songs have been covered by **Cher** and featured in films: **Evolution, Random Hearts**, and **Sliding Doors**. She is the recipient of an Honorary Doctorate of Music from Berklee College of Music.
