# **BACKLINE REQUIREMENTS**

## A. DRUMS

- 1.) LUDWIG Vistalite Drum Kit at the following specifications, with appropriate hardware:

- 1.) BASS AMP: Gallien Krueger 1001rb Head (Tube Bass amps are not accepted for Substitutions)
- 2.) BASS CABINET: Gallien Krueger [2] 4x10 Cabinets OR Ampeg SVT 8x10 Cabinet
- 1.) NO BACK BAR STOOL

# **C. GUITAR**

- 1.) GUITAR: Fender '65 Twin Reverb Guitar Amp (w/ Jensen Speakers)
- 2.) Approved substitutions. (Please approve any substitutions with FOH Engineer.)
- Fender Super Reverb

#### **D. AUDIO RENTAL & MISC REQUIREMENTS**

- 1.) TWO [2] Shure Shure ULX-D series (or similar) wireless transmitter & receiver w/ B98 cilp on mics
- 2.) TWO [2] Shure PSM 900 series, Sennheiser G3, or similar Wireless In Ear Monitor transmitter w/Body pack Receivers.
- 3.) THREE (3) No back bar stools.
- 4.) THREE (3) TURBO or equivalent stage fans.

#### **E. MONITOR REQUIREMENTS**

- Band sometimes travels with Two (2) IEM & One (1) wireless mic transmitter & receiver & clip on mic. For Bari Sax position
- Band requires one (2) additional wireless IEM receiver & transmitter
- Must have minimum of SEVEN [7] floor monitor wedges & drum sub on (seven). independent aux mixes. preferred 2-way w/ 12"s or 15" [active or passive is acceptable]
- 3 additional aux mixes for Wireless IEMs.

### F. FRONT OF HOUSE

- DIGITAL DESK STRONGLY PREFERRED BY EVERETT RAMOS
- SOUNDCRAFT Vi6/4, Midas PRO,6,3, 2, , ALL AVID DESKS, YAMAHA, CL5M7CL, PM5D, MIDAS M32, BERHINGER X32 SERIES, SOUNDCRAFT.. LARGE & MIDSIZE DESK WITH AT LEAST 24 INPUTS ACCEPTABLE
- 1 Talkbackmic for speaking on stage
- 4 FX's return TO CHNL. Room, Plate, Chorus, TAP Delay
- Sub on aux Preferred

#### **MONITOR SYSTEM**

- One qualified audio engineer to do the monitoring
- Monitor mixing desk 40/12 (MIDAS/SOUNDCRAFT/YAMAHA)
- ONE AVAILABLE Graphics EQ per aux/mix out. 1/3 octave 31 Bands (Klark DN360/BSS/DBX) PER OUTPUT SEND/AUX/MIX
- Minimum of ELEVEN [11] discrete mixes, FOUR [4] IEM AND SEVEN

#### **G. AUDIO ENGINEERS:**

- DIRTY DOZEN BRASS BAND tours with a FOH engineer. A monitor engineer will need to be provided, as well as at least one qualified in-house audio technician available to the touring,
- FOH engineer from the time of load in to load out. They will need to have knowledge of and
- access to any system processing and routing. DDBB's FOH Engineer will work with the House
- Monitor Engineer to line check monitors and get mixes up and running.

## H. SOUND CHECK:

- FOH Engineer would like to arrive 2hours prior to artist load-in
- Backline should arrive prior to FOH arrival
- After load-in, backline build, micing, cabling, stage patching is complete, DIRTY DOZEN BRASS BAND will require a minimum of 60min sound check on the day of performance, prior to the opening of the house.
- In cases that do not allow for a full sound check, such as festivals, please advance at least one week prior to event with DDBB's FOH Engineer.

# <u>I. LIGHTING</u>

- DDBB DOES NOT travel with a lighting package or Lighting Designer.
- The house is required to provide a professional lighting system equivalent to the needs of the venue and to suit a [7] piece band, with a qualified LD.
- Notes for the LD will be provided by the FOH engineer. We want the LD to have as much fun as possible and make the band look good!

## J. STAGING:

• STAGE DIMENSIONS: A stage of 28' WIDE X 16' DEEP is preferred.

• However, a minimum of 24' wide and 16' deep will be needed. If the stage is smaller please advance details with management ASAP

# **K. POWER:**

- 1.) FOUR [4] Quad power drops are required
- 2.) For all shows outside of the United States: THERE MUST BE A STEPDOWN

TRANSFORMER! and adaptors/power strips to accommodate US 110V plugs.

# L. RISERS:

• One [1] rolling drum riser with locking wheels at 24" tall and 8'x 8' in dimension
